My name is Richard Trevathan. I am a practicing attorney licensed in the State of Texas. My State of Texas bar card number is 20210600. In October, 1981, I was the Presiding Judge of the 182nd Criminal District Court of Harris County, Texas. In that capacity, I presided over the capital murder trial of the State of Texas v. Gary Graham. I presided over the trial from the beginning of jury selection through sentencing. I heard all fact witnesses during the phases of guilt or innocence and punishment.

During the guilt-innocence phase of the trial, I witnessed the testimony of Bernadine Skillern and her identification of Gary Graham, the defendant. I found all aspects of Ms. Skillern's testimony to be completely credible and worthy of belief. I agreed completely with the jury's verdict of guilty. In addition, at the conclusion of testimony pertaining to numerous violent extraneous offenses to which Gary Graham later pled guilty, I concurred completely with the jury's answer to the special issues presented to them. Those answers resulted in my pronouncing a death sentence for Gary Graham. To this day, I concur with that result.

I specifically oppose any application for commutation or

clemency. The jurors of Harris County have spoken. I support their verdict.
